A WORKSHOP ON FIRST AID

A workshop on providing First Aid in cases of emergency and information on safety measures was organized in Nosegay School Campus. The students were taught the method to provide first aid in case of accidents.

The significance of a first aid box was explained. Use of bandages, thermometer, anti-septic lotion, painkiller tablets and ointments etc. were taught.

In case of an accident, the victim should be examined carefully. Bleeding should be stopped by applying anti-septic lotion and tying of bandage. Fracture cases should be taken to the hospital with care.

Patients of epilepsy should be made to lie down straight to facilitate blood circula-

tion to the brain. In case of snake bite, a small incision should be made to let blood flow out and a handkerchief should be tied.

In case of a heart attack, the patient should be made to lie down comfortably. Lungs should be pressed with the palms at regular intervals. Then the patient should be taken to the hospital.

All the students, attentively listened to the information. Sri Manoj Kumar,

Divisional Warden Civil Defence and Sri Rajpal, Warden provided in this workshop.

Founder Chairman expressed the utility of this informative workshop and thanked the experts.

DISASTER MANAGEMENT CAMP

The Civil Defence Department, Sri Ganganagar organized a disaster management camp in the school campus. Chief Warden Civil Defence Department Sri Nirmal Jain educated the students about the various ways to combat fire accidents.

Sri Jain said that there are three major causes of fire-inflammable substances, suitable temperature and oxygen. It can be controlled by quick and immediate action. Fire extinguishers were claimed to be the most useful and the correct way of use was taught to the students.

Leakage in LPG cylinders in the kitchen, fire in engines of cars and short circuit in AC are

common accidents these days. Major tragedies can be controlled



by fire extinguishers. In the absence of fire extinguishers several precautions should be followed to control fire. Sri Jain said that in case of LPG cylinder fire, the knob of the cylinder should be closed or the cylinder

should be covered with a wet cloth which will obstruct the supply of oxygen and a blast will be avoided.

In case of a fire due to hot oil, a wet towel should be used to stop it. If the entire room gets filled with smoke due to a fire in the air conditioner, crawling out of the room is the best way to save life.

Sri Ved Prakash demonstrated the use of a fire extinguisher practically. Students and teachers were questioned about fire safety methods and given certificates.

Founder Chairman of the institute thanked Sri Nirmal Jain for sparing his valuable time and enlightening students.
